THE IMPACT

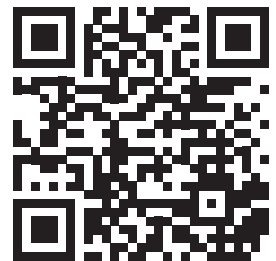
After just one year of being matched with a mentor, youth in our programs report:

- Increased self-confidence
- Better school performance
- Improved relationships with peers/family

Adults who mentor report:

- They "get more out of it" than the mentee
- Increased self-esteem and patience
- A sense of accomplishment

THE COMMITMENT

- Participate in a thorough onboarding process including an in-depth interview, training, and background & reference checks
- Spend at least 2 hours, twice per month with your Little (mentee), for at least 1 year
- Check in with your assigned Mentoring Relationship Specialist once per month regarding your relationship with your Little
