GET A MENTOR

In the Big Pride mentoring program, LGBTQIATS+ mentors are matched with LGBTQIATS+ youth (aged 12-16) to form a supportive friendship and help guide the youth through their teen years.

You can grow your LGBTQIATS+ child's village and help them realize and own their potential with a mentor.

IMPACT

After just one year of being matched with a mentor, youth in our programs report:

- Increased self-confidence
- Better school performance
- Improved relationships with peers/family

TO GET STARTED

Parent/Guardian submits an online application and participates in an in-depth interview to learn what the child needs in a mentor.

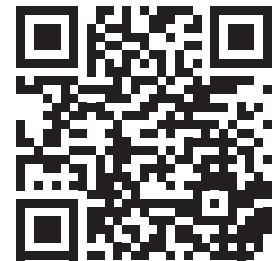
EXPECTATIONS OF YOUTH (LITTLES)

- Be willing and interested in being a part of the program
- Participate in an in-depth interview to share what would make the best mentor

EXPECTATIONS OF BOTH PARENT/GUARDIAN & YOUTH

Stay in touch with mentor (2 hours/twice monthly outings for Big & Little, minimum 1 year) and participate in monthly match support phone calls/texts with your Mentoring Relationship Specialist
